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Basic Package

Includes round-trip airfare, 2 nights at the hotel, 2 breakfasts, and transportation to and from the airport

The occupancy is 3 people per room. Those who wish to stay in a single room, please add 3,000 ¥ per night.

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Accommodation Hotel Information

Accommodations have been arranged at the ANA Hotel Sapporo. If you wish to stay here, you must book for both Friday and Saturday night.

The costs are as follows:

Friday, February 5th – 6th – 30,000 JPY

This rate includes breakfast for Saturday and Sunday morning. You may request up to 2 other roommates per room. All rooms will have 3 people in them, so if you do don't request a roommate, please be prepared to have two.

Friday, February 5th

Sapporo Beer Garden HEC Charity Enkai: 4,600 JPY

Includes tabe/nomihoudai of Hokkaido's signature beer and specialty food, Genghis Khan. Attendants will be entered into a raffle for Hokkaido themed prizes. There will also be several nijikais arranged to suit your taste – from dancing to bar hopping to karaoke.

Saturday, February 6th

Niseko Ski and Snowboard Package* TBA

Starting early in the morning, we set off for Niseko, famed for its luscious powder. This package includes an entire day of skiing and riding fun with lift pass, equipment rental, and transportation to and from Niseko. And for those with little experience on the slopes, volunteers will be around to help you out and give skiing and riding pointers.

Guided Snowshoe Day Trek* 8,000 JPY

This package is for those who want to experience the beauty of Hokkaido, but aren't in the mood for the slopes! Starting early in the morning, a guide from Japan Adventures will guide you through easy to moderate terrain. Lunch, gear rentals, and transportation are included.

* If you participate in the snowshoe trek, please provide your own appropriate winter clothing and water proof shoes or boots. For those attending the Niseko trip, snow pants and jackets are available for rental.

Otaru City Tour**

2,300 JPY

Known for its amazing glassware and its large shopping district, if you're looking for beauty, history and fun, Otaru is the place. This is a day-long trip.

Sapporo City Tour**

2,000 JPY

Moving beyond the ice sculptures, get to know the real Sapporo. The tour includes the Akarenga, Chocolate Factory, Tokeidai, and more.

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Important Information

Please read the following points carefully:

* To access the registration form, please visit the HAJET website (<http://www.hajet.org>) and click on the “Yuki Matsuri Registration Form” link under "Yuki Matsuri Tour" on the main menu. It is password protected. The password is *ym2010*. Some of the information is stuff you’ve already answered, but we are double-checking for clarity.

* Please fill in ALL information on the registration form. We aren’t asking for it to be annoying. It is required in order to book travel and accommodations.

* Once you register, you will receive an invoice from us detailing all of the things you have signed up for and their cost. This invoice will list your deposit amount due as well as the remaining balance due for your trip. All payments can be made by furikomi into the HAJET account listed on the invoice.

* Cancellations made between Dec. 5th and January 5th for the Basic Package will incur a 13,000 JPY cancellation fee. No cancellations for the Basic Package will be accepted after January 5th.

* The enkai begins at 7:30 pm on February 5th. For those of you booking your own travel, please keep this in mind regarding what time you will arrive in Sapporo.

* For those taking a ferry to Tomakomai, please keep in mind the extended travel time necessary for both legs of your journey. For those booking through HAJET, we will make sure to give you ample time to get to Sapporo for all activities.
