



HEC - Overview



HEC - During Covid-19

HEC was completely cancelled last year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Not only were students unable to attend the camp, they also couldn't take the test, which many were looking forward to.

For next year, we'd like to continue with the HEC test ONLY this year as long as COVID restrictions allow for it. There will be no camp or homestay prize for next year, but we have opened up registration to accommodate for the second years that missed out on HEC last year.


HEC - During Covid-19

We have increased the amount of winners this year. There will be 1 grand prize plus 2 runner up winners for **each grade** in the junior high and senior high categories separately, a total of 12 winners! The registration fee has also been lowered for this year.

The **Grand Prize** winner will receive up to 30,000 yen in English related gifts of the student's choosing.

The **second place** winner will receive up to 15,000 yen in English related gifts of the student's choosing.

The **third place** winner will receive up to 7,500 yen in English related gifts of the student's choosing.

Hokkaidō Newcomers Guide


A 'how-to' guide to living and working in Hokkaidō. It has the wisdom from JETs of years past!
